

ORDINANCE NO. 283

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE RATES TO BE CHARGED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER DEPARTMENT FOR WATER USAGE; PRESCRIBING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMER, NEBRASKA:

Section 1: Water Rates.

Effective on the billing date on or after March, 2025, to be made by users of water supplied by the Village of Palmer Water Department of the Village of Palmer, Nebraska, the rates charged by the Village Water Department shall be as follows:

Rates for water service to all residents will be \$42.25 for the first 1000 gallons and \$2.45 per thousand for additional use, to be billed monthly as outlined in §7-102 of the Municipal Code.

Rates for water service to all commercial businesses will be \$44.25 for the first 1000 gallons and \$2.45 per thousand for additional use, to be billed monthly as outlined in §7-102 of the Municipal Code.

Any residence or business that is connected to the water system but not using water shall be charged a non-use rate of \$42.25 for residential and \$44.25 for commercial, to be billed monthly as outlined in §7-102 of the Municipal Code.

Tapping fee for new water service will be \$150.00.

Section 2: Repealing Previous Ordinances

Any ordinance, part of any ordinance or resolution in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. Should any part or section of this ordinance be declared void, invalid, and unenforceable, such declaration shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.

Section 3: Effective Date; Publication authorized.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
